WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal
12	Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites,
13	improvements, and objects having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering, or
14	geographic significance; and
15	WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board"), after a public meeting on March 16,
16	2016, voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 1529 4th Avenue
17	West and the site on which the improvement is located (which collectively are referred to
18	as the "Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange" for the purposes of this
19	ordinance) for designation as a landmark under SMC Chapter 25.12; and
20	WHEREAS, after a public meeting on April 20, 2016, the Board voted to approve the
21	designation of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange under SMC Chapter
22	25.12; and
23	WHEREAS, on July 6, 2016, the Board and the owner of the designated landmark agreed to
24	controls and incentives; and
25	WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance
26	approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE,
27	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. CONTROLS: The following controls are hereby imposed on the features or characteristics of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange that were designated by

- Except as provided in subsection 2.A.2 or subsection 2.B of this ordinance, the owner must obtain a Certificate of Approval issued by the Board pursuant to SMC Chapter 25.12, or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired, before the owner may make alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange that were designated by the Board for preservation.
 - No Certificate of Approval is required for the following:
- Any in-kind maintenance or repairs of the features or characteristics of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange that were designated by
- Installation, removal, or alteration of the following landscape elements: trees less than 8 inches in diameter measured 4 1/2 feet above ground; shrubs;
- Installation, removal, or alteration of the following temporary site furnishings: benches; movable planter boxes; and movable water features.
- d. Installation or repair of underground utilities and irrigation, provided that the site is restored in kind.
- Installation, removal, or alteration of temporary interior window e. coverings.

B. <u>City Historic Preservation Officer Approval Process.</u>

- 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 of this ordinance according to the following procedure:
- a. The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
- b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.
- 2. If the CHPO does not approve the alterations or significant changes, the owner may submit revised materials to the CHPO, or apply to the Board for a Certificate of Approval under SMC Chapter 25.12. The CHPO shall transmit a written decision on the owner's request to the owner within 14 days of receipt of the request. Failure of the CHPO to timely transmit a written decision constitutes approval of the request.
- 3. CHPO approval of alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange that were designated by the Board for preservation is available for the following:
- a. For the specified features and characteristics of the building, the addition or elimination of fire escapes, ducts, conduits, HVAC vents, grilles, pipes, and other similar wiring or mechanical elements necessary for the normal operation of the building.
- b. Removal of hazardous trees more than 8 inches in diameter measured 4 1/2 feet above the ground.

Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in

SMC 25.12.910.

Section 5. The Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Garfield Exchange is hereby added alphabetically to Section II, Buildings, of the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.

The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Director of Records and Elections, deliver two certified copies to the CHPO, and deliver one copy to the Director of the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections. The CHPO is directed to provide a certified copy of this ordinance to the owner of the landmark.

1	Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
