10	WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance 124468 in 2014 authorizing the interlocal
11	agreement between the City of Seattle and the Seattle Park District, which included the
12	Seattle Park District Financial Plan: 2015-2020; and
13	WHEREAS, the Seattle Park District Financial Plan: 2015-2020 included the Park Land
14	Acquisition and Leverage Fund, which is to be used to acquire park lands, including
15	acquisition of properties to fill gaps in existing public ownership and preserve continuity
16	within the City's greenspaces; and
17	WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has determined the Kiwanis Ravine
18	Natural Area provides significant open space benefits including wildlife habitat,
19	recreational opportunities, buffer between the industrial and residential land-use and the
20	area is, therefore, a priority area for additional acquisitions for parks and open space; and
21	WHEREAS, the City has been trying to acquire the property at 4451 33 rd Avenue W for over a
22	decade and its acquisition will fill an important gap in the Kiwanis Ravine Natural Area;

D3a Section 1. The Superintendent of Parks and Recreation ("Superintendent"), or the 1 Superintendent's designee, is authorized, on behalf of The City of Seattle, to acquire the 2 following described real property, situated in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of 3 Washington, and commonly known as the property at 4451 33rd Avenue W ("Property"), 4 together with all rights, privileges, and other property pertaining thereto, for open space, park, 5 6 and recreation purposes: LOT 6, BLOCK 2, LAWTON HEIGHTS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN VOLUME 16 OF PLATS, PAGE 94, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON. 8 Section 2. The Superintendent, or the Superintendent's designee, is authorized, on behalf 10 11 12

of The City of Seattle, to negotiate and enter into an agreement to acquire the Property for a purchase price of \$158,000, and to accept a deed for the Property for open space, park and recreation purposes by attaching to the deed the Superintendent's written acceptance thereof, and recording the same.

Section 3. The Property shall be placed under the jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation.

Section 4. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken after its passage and prior to its effective date is ratified and confirmed.
