12	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:							
13	Section 1. Adjusting the pay zones for certain job titles in the Information Technology							
14	Professional (ITP) Compensation Program. The rates for 2015 shall be effective December 31,							
15	2014. The rates for 2016 shall be effective December 30, 2015. The rates for 2017 shall be							
16	effective December 28, 2016. The rates for 2018 shall be effective December 27, 2017.							
17	Information Technology Professional B. As recommended by the Seattle Human Resources							
18	Director, the hourly rates for the job title of Information Technology Professional B shall be							
19	adjusted for 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018 as shown below.
