**Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE relating to Seattle Public Utilities; updating and consolidating provisions relating to Seattle recycling requirements; and amending Sections 21.36.082 and 21.36.083 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

Summary and background of the Legislation: This legislation is necessary to streamline Seattle solid waste code and provide clear and consistent recycling requirements and enforcement. It consolidates Seattle Municipal Code amendments that have occurred over time, removes duplicative language, and clarifies certain enforcement actions. It also provides consistency with a King County Superior Court ruling declaring unconstitutional SPU contractor searches of trash cans to enforce Seattle's requirement compostable material be separated from garbage.
