1. BILL SUMMARY

a. Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE related to the City Light Department and the Department of Parks and Recreation; declaring certain real property rights surplus to the needs of the City Light Department; and transferring jurisdiction of the former Lakewood Substation from the City Light Department to the Department of Parks and Recreation for open space, park, and recreation purposes.

b. **Summary and background of the Legislation:** The former Lakewood Substation was acquired by Seattle City Light ("City Light") in 1956, as part of a system-wide expansion and modernization of the electric distribution system. The area surrounding the Lakewood Substation was later developed as Genesee Park, funded by the 1968 Forward Thrust bond issue. Still later, the Lakewood Substation became excess to City Light's needs as part of the utility's conversion from a 4 kV to a 26 kV electric distribution system.

In about 2000, the former Lakewood Substation was incorporated into the surrounding Genesee Park and Playfields. The transfer of a City Light property for park use requires a transfer of jurisdiction authorized by the City Council and reimbursement to the City Light Fund for the fair market value of the property.

This ordinance will provide the necessary legislative authorization and reimbursement to the City Light Fund, not made at the original time of transfer. City Light and the Department of Parks and Recreation have determined by independent appraisal that the fair market value of the property is \$210,000.
