Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125207, which adopted the 2017 Budget, including the 2017-2022 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; revising project allocations for certain projects in the 2017-2022 CIP; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

Summary and background of the Legislation: According to State law, all capital appropriations automatically carry forward unless explicitly abandoned through City Council action. This Ordinance abandons capital appropriation authority that was re-appropriated through the 2017-2018 budget process (Ordinance 125207), or was unused and is no longer needed.
