

**Amendment 8 to CB 119002 – Finding Need for Revenue for Education Services (Burgess)**

On page 2, beginning on line 20, amend the following subsection as shown below:

“7. ~~((The City has made investments in its children to address education equity and racial achievement gaps that persist in the City, such as through creation and support for the Seattle Preschool Program, the Families and Education Levy, and college and career readiness and success programs. But additional revenue tools are necessary to address the City’s education equity and racial achievement gaps.))~~ Additional revenue tools are necessary to address the City’s education equity and racial achievement gaps, recognizing that dedicated City funding for the Seattle Preschool Program is insufficient to meet the goals for universal pre-K, as approved by the voters, and that the city’s funding for Seattle Colleges’ 13<sup>th</sup> Year Promise Scholarship program falls short in providing community college tuition for all qualified and interested high school graduates and GED certificate achievers.”
