
Bitter Lake Reservoir

- 21.3 million gallons of storage
 - Operating and emergency water storage for surrounding areas
- Floating cover is in relatively good condition
- Construction projected 2022-23



Bitter Lake Reservoir

- Surrounding elevation at streets ~480 feet
- Elevation at top of reservoir ~510 feet



Constraints

- Need to keep top elevation similar to existing for water pressure zone management
- Need to keep total volume about the same
- Construction not needed until near the end of the floating cover's life
- Stormwater detention improvements



Exploring Site Options

- Retained services of landscape architect, JA Brennan & Assoc.
 - Early feasibility study
 - Exploring potential open space/recreational uses for cover replacement options
- Close coordination
 with Seattle
 Parks and Recreation



Site Options Status

- Completed site inventory, analysis, data collection
- Completed program definition/vision development
- Starting site options development
- Site options refinement to follow
- Report back to Council Q1 2018



Future Steps

- 2019-2021: Design, including public involvement
- 2022-2024: Construction
