

Proposal

Swedish Health Services is seeking a new permit for an existing pedestrian tunnel under Minor Ave, between Columbia St and Marion St

 - A connection between the Swedish Medical Center at 747 Broadway and the First Hill Medical Pavilion at 1124 Columbia St
 - Movement of hospital staff, supplies, and sterile instruments between the two buildings


Term permit history

 Initial approval granted in December 1986 and subsequently renewed to Swedish Health Services

 This new permit updates ownership, the permit and inspection fees, insurance requirements and adjusts the bond amount
