11	WHEREAS, The City of Seattle (City) acquired the real property located at 1933 Minor Avenue
12	(Property) in 1903 by Ordinance Number 22938 for use as Fire Station 15; the original
13	Fire Station 15 was demolished in 1950 and replaced with the current structure in 1951;
14	and the Seattle Fire Department ceased the use of the Property in 1972; and
15	WHEREAS, the Seattle Information Technology Department's Communication Shop began
16	using the Property in 1973; however, the site has become increasingly difficult for City
17	employees to access due to construction in the Denny Triangle; and
18	WHEREAS, the City's current use of the one-story Property is not the highest and best use of the
19	Property, which is located in a dense urban environment that is rapidly growing; NOW,
20	THEREFORE
21	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
22	Section 1. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administrative Services
23	(Director) or the Director's designee is authorized to execute and perform, for and on behalf of
24	The City of Seattle (City), a purchase and sale agreement (Agreement) with 1901 Minor, LLC
25	(1901 Minor) for the transfer of the property located at 1933 Minor Avenue, and legally
26	described as:

1 2 3 4 5	Lots 7 and 8, Block, 52, SECOND ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SEATTLE AS LAID OFF BY THE HEIRS OF SARAH A. BELL (DECEASED), commonly known as Heirs of Sarah A. Bell's Second Addition to the City of Seattle, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 1 of Plats, page 121, records of king County, Washington. SITUATE in the County of King, State of Washington
6	(Property) on the terms authorized in this ordinance.
7	Section 2. The Agreement shall be in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment
8	A, with such minor revisions and additions, not inconsistent with the express terms of this
9	ordinance or with applicable law, as the Director may determine are reasonably necessary to
10	carry out the intent of this ordinance.
11	Section 3. To carry out the Agreement for and on behalf of the City, the Director is
12	authorized to execute a deed for the Property in substantially the form attached as Exhibit C to
13	the Agreement and upon satisfaction or waiver of the conditions precedent under the Agreement,
14	the Director is authorized to cause the deed to be executed and delivered to 1901 Minor, LLC
15	and recorded in the real property records of King County.
16	Section 4. Of the Cash consideration, when received, \$11,000,000 shall be deposited in
17	the General Subfund (00100) and \$2,000,000 shall be deposited in the Low-Income Housing
18	Fund (16400).
