

1 **Amendment to Resolution 31810 – Unauthorized Encampment Removal (CM Sawant)**
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5 Section 1. Proceeds from the new business tax imposed by the ordinance introduced as
6 Council Bill 119244 are intended to be used to expand housing, shelter, public health, hygiene,
7 sanitation, and other support services for those who are homeless or at significant risk of
8 homelessness, with priority for assisting those homeless people living unsheltered and/or with
9 very low incomes (at or below 30 percent of area median income (AMI). It is intended that 75
10 percent of the proceeds from the new business tax will be used to increase the production of
11 long-term affordable housing, and fund operations and services support for housing serving the
12 homeless who are most vulnerable. Twenty percent of the proceeds from the new business tax
13 will be used to increase the provision and effectiveness of shelter, public health, hygiene,
14 sanitation, and support services to assist homeless people living unsheltered to move off the
15 streets. It is intended that none of the revenue generated by the tax will be used to support
16 unauthorized encampment removals. Attachment 1 to this resolution establishes the spending
17 plan for the first five years of the new business tax.

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
