THIS LEGISLATION

Adds a new SMC Section 21.49.095 codifying that City Light

- ■Complies with applicable state law RCW 19.29A.100 protecting utility customer information
- Only uses customer data for providing utility services, implementing efficiency programs, and managing the electric grid

Continued ...

- Complies with the City's Privacy Program (<u>Resolution 31570</u>)
 and has completed and posted for the public a Privacy Impact Assessment covering
 - The data collected
 - Access to the data
 - Allowable uses of the data

Continued ...

- Uses industry best practice for handling and transmitting data including
 - Robust encryption of the data
 - Anonymization of the data
 - Limiting access and use of the data

Continued ...

- •Will require all third-party contractors with access to customer data to comply with SMC 21.49.095
- Provides an opt-out option for customers who do not wish to have an advanced meter
