It is anticipated that 15 such authorization will not be granted until the Seattle Department of Transportation 16 reports to the Sustainability & Transportation Committee, or its successor committee, on 17 the 10% design baseline package"; 18 WHEREAS, the Seattle Department of Transportation reported to the Sustainability & 19 Transportation Committee on June 19, 2018, in accordance with Green Sheet 49-1-A-1-20 2018; NOW, THEREFORE, 21 22 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: Section 1.
