11	WHEREAS, the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the renovation of the Seattle Center				
12 Arena identifies significant transportation related impacts; and					
13	WHEREAS, the City and Oak View Group share a goal of reducing the rate of single-				
14	occupancyprivate vehicle trips to events at the Seattle Center Arena over time; and				
15	WHEREAS, the draft Arena Access Management Plan identifies(August 2018) identified				
16	preliminary mode share goals of 31 percent of National Hockey League or National				
17	Basketball Association game attendees walking, biking, taking transit, or the monorail by				
18	2020, increasing to 38 percent by 2025 and 49 percent by 2035; and				
19	WHEREAS, the City's Comprehensive Plan has a mode share goal for the Uptown Urban Center				
20	of 85% of non-work trips using travel modes other than driving alone by 2035.				
21	WHEREAS, mode share goals for the Seattle Center Arena are anticipated to behave been				
22	established as part of the Master Use Permit for the project.				
23	WHEREAS, regardless of other transportation modes, all event attendees will be pedestrians at				
24	some point during their trip; and				

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	1	WHEREAS, the City has a goal of becoming carbon-neutral by 2050, and recognizes the
	2	environmental benefits of sustainable modes of transportation such as walking, biking,
	3	and taking transit; and
Í	4	WHEREAS, the City is committed to building a safe, basic bike network for all ages, languages,
	5	ethnicities, genders, races, and abilities; Ages, Languages, Ethnicities, Genders, Races,
	6	and Abilities (ALEGRA); and
I	7	WHEREAS, new Sound Transit light rail stations are scheduled to open beginning in 2021,
	8	including a station at Seattle Center in 2035; and
	9	WHEREAS, the City and Oak View Group have worked with north Downtown neighborhoods
	10	to create the North Downtown Mobility Action Plan (NODO MAP) to recommend and
	11	prioritize projects to improve mobility throughout north Downtown; and
	12	WHEREAS, the Monorail Stations Reconfiguration Evaluation Report identifies and evaluates
	13	potential improvements to the Seattle Monorail to increase capacity, improve
	14	accessibility, and better connect to the regional transit network; and
	15	WHEREAS, voices from the community have been and should continue to be included in
I	16	planning discussions for transportation priorities in the area; NOW, THEREFORE,
	17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT:
	18	Section 1. The City Council acknowledges that the Executive has established
	19	requirements for State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) mitigations for the Seattle Center
	20	Arena renovation, as well as initial proposals for specific investments in transportation pursuant
	21	to the NODO MAP recommendations that will inform investments made as part of the Seattle
	22	Center Arena City Transportation Fund. The City Council requests that the Seattle Department
I	23	of Transportation (SDOT), the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI), and

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1	Seattle Center prepare a written report identifying planned transportation projects impacting
2	Lower Queen Annein the vicinity of the Uptown Urban Center, other north Downtown
3	neighborhoods, and the Seattle Center Arena. The report should describe the implementation
4	status, source of funding, and construction schedule for each project. The report should <u>then</u>
5	identify which projects are associated with State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) and Master
6	Use Permit requirements for the Seattle Center Arena renovation, and the projects which will be
7	implemented through the Seattle Center Arena City Transportation Mitigation Fund, and the
8	North Downtown Mobility Action Plan The City Council requests that the Executive submit
9	this report in writing to all members of Seattle City Council by June 30, 2019 should also identify
10	the projects associated with the NODO MAP process.
11	Section 2. As part of the written report described in Section 1 of this Resolution, The City
12	Council requests that SDCI and SDOT prepare a written report describingdescribe how The City
13	of Seattle and Oak View Group will administer the Arena Access Management Plan for the
14	Seattle Center Arena to achieve the mode-split goals established for the project, and what steps
15	will be taken if the mode-split goals are not met-, consistent with the Master Use Permit decision
16	for the project. The report should identify the opportunities for community
17	stakeholderstakeholders to provide input into these decisions. The City Council requests that the
18	Executive submit this report in writing to all members of the City Council by June 30, 2019the
19	process to administer the Arena Access Management Plan.
20	Section 3. The City Council requests that the Executive submit the report described in
21	Section 1 and Section 2 of this Resolution in writing to all members of Seattle City Council by
22	June 30, 2019. The City Council further requests that the Executive provide a written annual
23	status report to all members of Seattle City Council on any significant changes to the project list,

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- 1 status of the projects, or management of the Arena Access Management Plan to achieve the
- 2 mode-split goals established for the project by June 30 of each year until the Seattle Center
- 3 Arena begins operations.
