MHA Milestones

- ✓ 2015: City adopts a workplan for MHA implementation
- ✓ 2015 and 2016: City establishes the regulatory framework for commercial and residential development
- ✓ 2017: City implements MHA through rezone legislation in parts of the University District, Downtown, South Lake Union, Uptown, Chinatown International District, and nodes along the 23rd Avenue Corridor in the Central Area
- 2018: City considers implementation in remaining urban centers and villages and multifamily and commercially zoned areas outside of urban centers and villages

Amendment Process

- Generally, amendments will be of two kinds: (1) changes to zone designations on the Official Land Use Map (i.e. rezones) and (2) changes to substantive or procedural standards in the text of the zoning code.
- Proposed amendments must be within the scope of environmental review in the Final Environmental Impact Statement for Citywide Implementation of Mandatory Housing Affordability, as modified by the additional review required by the Hearing Examiner's decision.
- Potential amendments should be identified early in the process to allow time for staff to analyze them and provide the public with an opportunity to comment on them at the public hearing.
