About the Timber Pavilion

A gift to Seattle Parks and Recreation from the Seattle Parks Foundation.

In partnership with Alliance for Pioneer Square.

About the pavilion:

- 13- by 17-foot wood/steel structure using current timber technologies
- Includes a covered space for play, performance, and gathering
- Provides information and concierge station for residents and visitors
- Allows for enhanced park activation



Public Outreach

Led by Alliance for Pioneer Square in coordination with Seattle Parks Foundation, Downtown Seattle Association and Seattle Parks and Recreation, we held:

- 2 open house events for community members
- 1 online open house
- 5 information tables at Pioneer Square events
- 3 information meetings with neighborhood organizations

- The Seattle Parks Foundation takes full responsibility for payment of design, permitting and construction.
- Pioneer Square Preservation Board Certificate of Approval is pending.
- The City (Seattle Parks and Recreation) will provide design review and construction oversight.
- The City will take full ownership of the pavilion, once completed.
