- Creates two new capital projects

## **Ordinance Details**

- State & Federal Grants (\$33.7M)
  - 2018 grant applications were authorized by ordinance 125471
- Funding Agreements (\$16.2M)
  - Washington State Convention Center, Oak View Group, DSA
  - King County, Sound Transit
  - SCL, SPU, OPCD
- New CIP Projects
  - STBD Capital Improvements
  - NODO MAP Improvements
