

MICHAEL DIAZ



Prior to moving to Seattle, Michael Diaz lived in New Hampshire for 20 years where he had a varied and interesting career, highlighted by his work with society's most vulnerable. In the 1970s, Michael worked for the state hospital as a psychiatric aid on the violent ward, even sustaining a broken foot during his service.

Michael then worked for the Manchester School Department in several capacities. As a high-school classroom aide in a high-poverty school, Michael tutored students in preparation of standardized testing. Michael also worked for the school district as a classroom supervisor to enable highly disruptive kids the opportunity to join the classroom. Michael continued his work with children at the New Hampshire Youth Development Center from 1984-1989.

After a brief foray into banking and a couple years in Pittsburg, Michael moved to Seattle at the suggestion of his daughter. Michael worked for Plymouth Housing in Seattle from 2002-2004 as a front desk staff member. In this role, Michael ran the front desk of a residential building, interacting with residents, conducting floor checks, and performing cleaning tasks.

Michael returned to New Hampshire for several years after his daughter's death, but returned to Seattle for the weather, mainly our beautiful summers. Back in Seattle, Michael returned to Plymouth Housing in 2007 working in their rental office. In 2012 Michael earned a promotion to assistant manager of the rental office, and the following year Michael again was promoted to the role of manager.

In 2015 Michael retired, and in March of 2016 Michael became a Resident of Seattle Housing Authority (SHA). Michael is currently keeping busy in his retirement writing a book on paranormal activity.
