Add other factors for the Council to consider in the development of new legislation

On page 4 after line 3, amend the following Section as shown below:

Section 1. The City Council ("Council") intends to consider legislation in 2020 that

would expand the Commuter Benefits Ordinance, Chapter 14.30 of the Seattle Municipal

Code, to require employers to provide employees with transit subsidies, while taking into

consideration the differing abilities of employers to absorb these costs and administer the transit

subsidies based on the number of employees and other factors that could include the personnel

resources available to administer the transit subsidies, the displacement risks facing the

employer's organization or business, and other factors indicating or impacting the financial

wellbeing of the employer's organization or business.

Effect: This amendment would add other factors for the Council to consider in the

development of an updated ordinance.
