This project will stabilize the structure to prevent catastrophic failure and either repair the structure to carry traffic or replace the structure. Prior to closure, the West Seattle Bridge was the most travelled arterial street governed by SDOT, carrying 84,000 vehicles and 17,000 transit riders daily.
