Amendment Name: Pepper Spray Restrictions

Sponsor: Councilmember Sawant

Effects Statement: Prohibits the use of pepper spray for crowd control in a demonstration or

rally.

Proposed Amendment:

Modify Sections 2.D and 2.E as follows:

D. ((Oleoresin capsicum (OC) spray, forty-millimeter launchers and noise flash

diversionary devices are not ((is not a crowd control weapon))less lethal ((crowd

control)) weapons for purposes of owning, purchasing, renting, or storing under subsection

3.28.146.A., unless such weapons are used for crowd dispersal purposes.)) Neither 40-millimeter

launchers to deploy chemical irritants, nor pepper spray, nor noise flash diversionary devices are

banned as less lethal weapons for purposes of subsection 3.28.146.A. with the exception that

they may not be used for crowd control in a demonstration or rally, and only in circumstances in

which the risk of serious injury from violent actions outweighs the risk of harm to bystanders.

Only Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) officers may deploy such 40-millimeter launchers to

deploy chemical irritants and noise flash diversionary devices and only for purposes other than

crowd control in demonstration or rally.

((E. Oleoresin capsicum (OC) spray is not banned as a less lethal weapon for purposes of

subsection 3.28.146.A. with the exceptions that a) it may not be used for crowd control in a non-

violent demonstration or rally and b) it may be used only in circumstances in which the risk of

serious injury from violent actions outweighs the risk of harm to bystanders.))
