Amendment Name: Right of action during a violent public disturbance

Sponsor: Councilmember Herbold

<u>Effects Statement</u>: This amendment would make the right of private action available to persons impacted by the Police violating provisions of this Council Bill at any time, including during a violent public disturbance.

Proposed Amendment:

Modify Section 1H as follows:

((E))H. A person shall have a right of action against the City for physical or emotional injuries proximately caused by the use of ((erowd control)) less lethal weapons in violation of this Section 3.28.146((for crowd dispersal)) that occur in a gathering that is not a violent public disturbance after this ordinance takes effect. A person who, in the judgment of a reasonable person, commits a criminal offense at or immediately prior to the use of less lethal force may not recover under this Section 3.28.146.
