Amendment to the Recitals:and

WHEREAS, to minimize as many barriers to access to counsel as possible while limiting access to those with financial obstacles, this ordinance would require tenants to qualify for representation due to indigency;

Amendment to Section 1:

Seattle Municipal Code 22.206.195.A

A. Any tenant residing in Seattle who is named in an unlawful detainer suit under chapter 59.18 RCW has the right to legal counsel free of charge as set forth in this Section 22.206.195, ~~regardless of the person's ability to pay~~ if the tenant is indigent. For the purposes of this Section, a person is "indigent" who, at any stage of an unlawful detainer suit, is unable to pay the cost of counsel for representation in the unlawful detainer suit because the person's available funds are insufficient to retain counsel. Any entity with which the City contracts for legal representation provided under this Section is authorized to establish the process for determining and verifying a tenant's indigent status.
