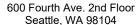

# CITY OF SEATTLE ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_ COUNCIL BILL

- AN ORDINANCE relating to emergency communications; amending Ordinance 126237, which adopted the 2021 Budget; transferring positions from the Seattle Police Department to the Community Safety and Communications Center; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.
- WHEREAS, throughout the summer of 2020, Seattle residents took to the streets to protest the unjust murders of Black Americans, including George Floyd and Breonna Taylor and the shooting of Jacob Blake; all of these individuals experienced violent and lethal force at the hands of the police; and
- WHEREAS, in response to this local and national civil rights reckoning, community members and civic leaders, including the Mayor and members of the City Council, have committed to a holistic review and community-led discussion around the effectiveness of the current way that community safety is provided in Seattle; and
- WHEREAS, the shared vision for reimagining Seattle's system of community safety recognizes the importance of providing alternatives to armed police officer response, including civilian and community-based services and solutions; and
- WHEREAS, based on community input, the Mayor and the City Council have pursued the transfer of certain functions out of the Seattle Police Department, including Emergency Management, 9-1-1 Dispatch, Crime Victim Advocates, and Parking Enforcement; and
- WHEREAS, these transfers, taken in total, aim to reflect community expectations of the equitable delivery of

  City services, elevate emergency planning, improve the coordination of calls-for-service, increase

  civilian and community-based dispatch options, and bolster public trust and confidence in a reimagined

system of community safety; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the new Community Safety and Communications Center allows the City to explore consolidation and co-location of communications and dispatch functions, design and develop alternate emergency response models, as well as incorporate civilian and community-based dispatch alternatives that draw on the wealth of resources that currently exist in Seattle that could replace or complement armed officer response to better meet community needs; NOW, THEREFORE,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2021 Adopted Budget is amended by amending a Budget Summary Level as follows:

Community Safety and Communications Center

On May 11, 2021, the Public Safety and Human Services Committee will discuss and possibly vote on Council Bill (CB) 120065, which would transfer 9-1-1 call center positions and parking enforcement officer (PEO) positions from the Seattle Police Department (SPD) to the Community Safety and Communications Center (CSCC). This memo provides a brief legislative history related to the CSCC and describes the positions that would be transferred by the bill.

#### **Background**

On November 23, 2020, as part of the 2021 budget process, the City Council passed Ordinance 126233, establishing a new CSCC within the Executive Department. Ordinance 126233 provided that the CSCC would initially provide two functions: police 9-1-1 dispatch and parking enforcement services. Moving these functions to the CSCC was intended to help reframe how the City provides for community safety and respond to the Council's interest in exploring expanded duties for the PEOs. Ordinance 126233 provided that the CSCC would begin performing the 9-1-1 call center functions by June 1, 2021 and that the CSCC would begin performing parking enforcement functions on June 1, 2021.

Ordinance 126233 differed from the approach included in the Mayor's 2021 Proposed Budget, which would have moved the PEOs to the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) and moved the police 9-1-1 call center to a new Seattle Emergency Communications Center beginning January 1, 2021.<sup>2</sup>

During Council's consideration of the Mayor's 2021 Proposed Budget, the Executive identified the need for additional lead time to start up the new CSCC. The City Council included a <u>proviso</u> in the 2021 Adopted Budget, allowing the Executive to charge parking enforcement and 9-1-1 expenses against the SPD budget until June 1, 2021.<sup>3</sup> The budget proviso also requested that the Executive provide a detailed estimate by March 31, 2021 of additional staff and budget that

would be required to support the potential expansion of the PEOs' responsibilities.<sup>4</sup> Ordinance 126233 did not transfer existing personnel to the CSCC because the new agency could not become fully operational until the City received the necessary federal Originating Agency Identifier (ORI). Council anticipated that the Executive would send separate legislation to make the personnel transfers and add any additional positions by June 1, 2021.

The Council also approved two related Statements of Legislative Intent, requesting reports by the end of March 2021 on the cost of using PEOs for traffic control during special events and on merging or co-locating the SPD and Seattle Fire Department (SFD) 9-1-1 call centers. None of the three reports have yet been provided to Council. The Executive has continued to advocate for transferring the PEOs to SDOT, citing (a) previous collaboration between the PEOs and SDOT's Curbside Management Team and (b) the observation that no other municipalities have detached parking enforcement from a public works, transportation, or police reporting structure. The Executive reported to the Committee on April 27, 2021 that City Budget Office Director Noble will request extensions to the report deadlines, due in part to union demands to bargain.

CB 120065, sponsored by Councilmember Herbold, would move the SPD 9-1-1 call center and PEOs to the CSCC, consistent with Ordinance 126233 and the 2021 Adopted Budget. As described below, it would transfer 140 positions from the SPD 9-1-1 call center and 120 parking enforcement positions from SPD to the CSCC. The bill includes a "ratify and confirm" clause that would allow the Executive to implement acts consistent with the authority of the legislation prior to its effective date, which would be after the June 1, 2021 deadline in the budget proviso.<sup>7</sup>

#### **CSCC Positions**

CB 120065 would transfer the following 140 SPD 9-1-1 call center positions from SPD to the CSCC:

- Dispatchers (109);
- Police Communications Analysts (7);
- Dispatcher Supervisors (20);
- Administrative Specialist II (1); and
- Manager II (3).

CB 120065 would also transfer the following 120 parking enforcement positions from SPD to the CSCC:

- Parking Enforcement Officers (106);
- Parking Enforcement Officer Supervisors (12);
- One Administrative Specialist (1); and
- Manager III (1).

In addition to hiring a new Director as authorized in Ordinance 126233, the Executive anticipates that additional "back of house" positions (e.g., human resources and finance) will be needed to support one or both of the CSCC functions and plans to submit a proposal in the 2022 budget. In the meantime, the Executive appointed SFD Deputy Chief Chris Lombard to become CSCC Interim Director on March 8. Interim Director Lombard has retained temporary assistance to help set up the new CSCC.

#### **Committee Action**

Options for Council action are as follows:

- Pass CB 120065. CB 12006 would transfer the SPD 9-1-1 dispatch positions and PEO positions to the CSCC;
- 2. Amend CB 120065 to remove the transfer of PEO positions to the CSCC; and then introduce and pass the Executive's transmitted legislation that would transfer the PEO positions and appropriations to SDOT; or
- 3. Take no action. The Executive and/or Council would need to take some future action to meet the payroll for the positions that would remain in SPD.

  WHEREAS, Resolution 31962, adopted by the City Council ("Council") on August 10, 2020, stated that the
- Council would not support any budget amendments to increase the Seattle Police Department's (SPD) budget to offset overtime expenditures above the funds budgeted in 2020 or 2021, and expressed the Council's intent to reduce SPD's budget in phases and increase funding for community-led research and participatory budgeting; and
- WHEREAS, the ordinance introduced as Council Bill 119970, introduced after adoption of the 2021 Budget, increased SPD's 2020 budget by \$5.4 million; and
- WHEREAS, the Council believes that SPD would have had sufficient appropriation authority to cover the \$5.4 million had it not overspent its overtime budget, due largely to over-deployment of officers during the largely peaceful demonstrations in the summer of 2020, including a deployment of officers that exceeded \$10 million in overtime costs in less than 60 days; and
- WHEREAS, the Council anticipates that there will be salary savings in SPD's budget in 2021 due to higher than anticipated attrition that has already occurred in October 2020 and may continue to occur during November 2020 and December 2020 and is continuing into 2021; and
- WHEREAS, reducing SPD's 2021 appropriation authority offsets the increased authority provided in 2020 and increases funding for the community-led participatory budgeting work called for in Resolution 31962;

NOW, THEREFORE,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council (Council) finds and declares:

A. The Seattle Police Department (SPD) has experienced an unprecedented number of officer separations over the past eight months, culminating in the separation of 186 officers by the end of 2020. In total, SPD had 135 fewer officers than at the start of 2020, with only 51 officers hired, partly resulting from the citywide hiring freeze ordered by the Mayor in response to budget shortfalls resulting from the COVID pandemic. The trend in additional separations appears to be continuing in 2021 as SPD reported that a total of 22 officers separated and 22 recruits hired in January.

B. SPD has and may continue to realize salary savings in 2021 because the Adopted Budget provided salaries for many officers that separated late in 2020, either during the development of the 2021 Adopted Budget or shortly after it was adopted.

- C. A Council Central Staff Analysis found that the unplanned separations in 2020 could result in as much as \$7.7 million in salary savings in 2021.
- D. The Mayor's 2021 Proposed Budget cut \$4.1 million in civilian salary funding, which requires SPD to hold unfilled approximately 40 civilian positions. This cut was included in the City's 2021 Adopted Budget.
- E. SPD has expressed an interest in using its salary savings on expenditures that will help to mitigate the loss of officers, to respond to calls for more transparency and accountability, and to allow the agency to continue its compliance with the 2012 Federal Consent Decree. The expenditures requested by SPD include:
- 1. \$1,400,000 on civilian positions including 2.0 FTE Crime Prevention Coordinators, 4.0 FTE Community Service Officers, 1.0 FTE Community Service Officer Supervisor, 1.0 FTE Management Systems Analyst Supervisor, 2.0 FTE Administrative Staff Analysts for public disclosure and 1.0 FTE Sr. Management Systems Analyst;
  - 2. \$2,185,000 on technology investments that include maintenance and expansion of the Data

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Analytics Platform, purchase of a capacity planning tool that will allow SPD to evaluate demand for 911 response, calculate staffing requirements and determine "future state" based on scenarios such as 911 alternate responses, an Innovation Blueprint that would increase transparency, build public trust, and improve police practices as called for by Executive Order 2020-10 and an Early Intervention System that would expand capacity for predicting and guiding interventions for employees exhibiting signs they need support, all of which would support SPD's ability to comply with the Federal Consent Decree; and

3. Up to \$1,800,000 on separation pay for officers and civilians that are projected to leave in 2021, including payout of unused vacation time and other costs associated with separation from the City.

F. In a March 2015 Audit, the City Auditor found that staffing issues in SPD's Public Disclosure unit hinder SPD's ability to ensure accurate and timely responses, provide reasonable assurance of compliance with state law, and promote transparency and public trust. The Council agrees with City Auditor recommendations and supports: (1) the hiring of the 2.0 FTE Administrative Staff Analysts identified in finding D.1; (2) the hiring of an additional 1.0 FTE Administrative Staff Analyst; (3) a dedication of no fewer than 2.0 FTE Administrative Staff Analysts funded through the Office of Police Accountability to work on public records requests made of the Office of Police Accountability; and (4) the addition of 1.0 FTE Information Technology Specialist position that is funded in the Seattle Information Technology Department but is dedicated to SPD public disclosure e-mail search and may be housed inside of the Seattle Police Department Headquarters Building.

G. In a December 2020 Audit, the Office of the Inspector General for Public Safety found that SPD's evidence storage facility is inadequate leading to improper destruction of DNA evidence and purging of evidence from an unknown number of homicide investigations. The Council finds that the Department of Finance and Administrative Services can begin to address storage capacity issues with an additional \$500,000 to dedicate towards additional leased space for SPD.

H. The SPD Crisis Response Team (CRT), which pairs specially trained officers with mental health

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professionals funded in the Human Services Department to assist individuals in mental health crises, should be augmented with an additional five mental health responders to better enable it to connect individuals in crisis to resources to help to address their physical and mental health needs, to divert them from the criminal justice system, and to better equip officers who are responding to 911 calls that require interaction with persons in crisis, who may also be a threat to the safety of the officers or the public.

- I. SPD has a sufficient amount of salary savings to fund position costs for half of 2021 for at least the positions identified in these findings as well as the technology investments, separation pay, CRT investment, and investments in public disclosure and evidence storage space. Additionally, SPD has sufficient salary savings to absorb a cut of \$2.0 million that can be redirected towards the City's Participatory Budgeting efforts.
- J. The Council will, through separate legislation, provide any necessary position authority to allow SPD to hire the civilian positions that will be funded with salary savings.
- K. The Council recognizes the importance of SPD's need to plan for use of future salary savings to address emerging issues related to the COVID pandemic and the timing and availability of vaccines to the general public. Such issues may include the need to use salary savings to address costs related to a resurgence in special events or for patrol augmentation that would help to offset staffing losses. The Council finds that an amendment of a \$5.0 million salary savings proviso in the 2021 Adopted Budget (CBA-011-B-002) would allow SPD more flexibility to plan for these and other emerging fiscal issues.
- L. The Council expresses its ongoing interest in monitoring SPD salary savings and will do so with the assistance of the sworn staffing reports requested in Council Budget Action SPD-003-A-003 as adopted in Clerk File 314464.

"Of the appropriation in the 2021 budget for the Finance General, General Purpose Budget Summary Level (00100-BO-FG-2QD00), \$2,000,000 is appropriated solely to implement actions recommended to the City from the Participatory Budgeting process and may be spent for no other purpose. Furthermore, none of the

money so appropriated may be spent until authorized by future ordinance. Council anticipates that such authority will not be granted until the Executive submits to the Council a plan for spending the funds in accordance with the Participatory Budgeting recommendations."

Section 5. Council Budget Action SPD-011-B-002 of Clerk File 314464 is amended as follows:

This Council Budget Action would impose the following proviso: "Of the appropriation in the 2021 budget for the Seattle Police Department, \$5 million may not be spent ((until authorized by a future ordinance)) until the Seattle Police Department complies with the terms of Statement of Legislative Intent SPD-003-A-003 of this Clerk File, including the provision of forecasted separation and hiring numbers in 2021 and 2022, and a copy of the SLI responses have been filed with the City Clerk. For each monthly report received by the City Clerk between May 19, 2021 and December 21, 2021, \$625,000 shall be released and the \$5.0 million proviso will be reduced accordingly."

The Council's intent in amending this proviso is that SPD staff have access to future salary savings to fund its staffing plan.

Section 6. The Council intends that use of salary savings for overtime costs above those budgeted in 2021 for special events, including staffing mass vaccination sites, should be consistent with an events staffing deployment approach that ensures, excepting security within facilities, non-sworn SPD staff are prioritized to provide events staffing so sworn staff can be prioritized for patrol staffing and 911 response needs, consistent with:

- 1. The 2017 City Audit finding that "at many special events, SPD sworn personnel perform work that is primarily traffic-directing" and recommendation to "evaluate the traffic-centric special events work SPD sworn officers perform and consider using non-sworn personnel for some of it;"
- 2. The Special Event shared work jurisdiction between Seattle Parking Officers' Guild ("SPEOG") and Seattle Police Officers' Guild ("SPOG") as described in the Memorandum of Agreement on September 29, 2018; and

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3. SPD Manual 14.100: If event staffing requires more resources beyond Traffic Section personnel, Non-Traffic volunteers are solicited.

Section 7. The Council establishes its intent that SPD, to the extent possible, uses salary savings from unanticipated, extraordinary officer separations to fund the position costs and investments within SPD identified in Section 1, findings E and F. The Council also recognizes the flexibility that SPD budget staff need to address emerging issues and mitigate recent officer attrition and staffing issues. The Council requests that SPD prioritize its salary saving expenditures to fulfill its obligations under the Federal Consent Decree and its Charter responsibility to provide adequate public safety services to those who visit, live, and work in Seattle.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

#### 1. BILL SUMMARY

**Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 126237, which adopted the 2021 Budget, including the 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; and adding or modifying provisos.

**Summary and background of the Legislation:** This legislation would reduce appropriations in the Seattle Police Department's (SPD) 2021 Adopted Budget by \$5.4 million and increase appropriations in Finance General for participatory budgeting by the same amount and imposes a proviso.

Council Bill 119970, introduced after adoption of the 2021 budget and will be acted on by the City Council on December 14, 2020, will, if passed, increases SPD's 2020 budget by \$5.4 million. Resolution 31962, adopted by the Council on August 10, 2020, stated that the City Council would not support any budget amendments to increase the SPD's budget to offset overtime expenditures above the funds budgeted in 2020 or 2021 and expressed Council's intent to reduce SPD's budget in phases and increase funding for community-led research and participatory budgeting.

Reducing 2021 appropriation authority through separate legislation would offset the increased authority provided in 2020 and increase funding for the community-led work. Further, the Council expresses its intent that the anticipated amendment to SPD's 2021 appropriation authority will recognize salary savings achieved by higher than anticipated attrition that has already occurred in October 2020 and may continue to occur during November 2020 and December 2020.

Section <u>34</u>. This ordinance imposes a proviso, as follows:

"Of the appropriation in the 2021 budget for the Finance General, General Purpose Budget Summary Level (00100-BO-FG-2QD00), \$5,388,072-\$2,000,000 is appropriated solely to implement actions recommended to the City from the Participatory Budgeting process and may be spent for no other purpose. Furthermore, none of the money so appropriated may be spent until authorized by future ordinance. Council anticipates that such authority will not be granted until the Executive submits to the Council a plan for spending the funds in accordance with the Participatory Budgeting recommendations."

Section 5. Council Budget Action SPD-011-B-002 of Clerk File 314464 is amended as follows:

This Council Budget Action would impose the following proviso: "Of the appropriation in the 2021 budget for the Seattle Police Department, \$5 million may not be spent ((until authorized by a future ordinance)) until the Seattle Police Department complies with the terms of Statement of Legislative Intent SPD-003-A-003 of this Clerk File, including the provision of forecasted separation and hiring numbers in 2021 and 2022, and a copy of the SLI responses have been filed with the City Clerk. For each monthly report received by the City Clerk between May 19, 2021 and December 21, 2021, \$625,000 shall be released and the \$5.0 million proviso will be reduced accordingly."

The Council's intent in amending this proviso is that SPD staff have access to future salary savings to fund its staffing plan.

## CB 119981 Amendment 1 Summary:

### Proviso Change

- Amends Council Budget Action SPD-011-B-002 (\$5 million Salary Savings Proviso):
  - \$5 million may not be spent until the Seattle Police Department complies with the terms of Statement of Legislative Intent SPD-003-A-003 (Sworn Staffing Reports), including the provision of forecasted separation and hiring numbers in 2021 and 2022.
  - For each monthly report received by the City Clerk between May 2021 and December 2021, \$625,000 shall be released and the \$5.0 million proviso will be reduced accordingly."
- The Council's intent in amending this proviso is that SPD staff have access to future salary savings to fund the SPD staffing plan.

## CB 119981 Amendment 1 Summary:

### Legislative Intent for <u>current</u> Salary Savings

- SPD should spend its salary savings on the items requested in its January Memo to the Public Safety and Human Services Committee and noted in its letter to the Court Monitor.
- Two Administrative Staff Assistants should be dedicated to processing public disclosure requests related to the Office of Police Accountability.
- Department of Finance & Administrative Services staff should make available additional evidence storage space for SPD.
- Seattle IT staff should provide e-mail searches for SPD public disclosure requests.
- The Human Service Department should add five contracted Mental Health Professionals to SPD's Crisis Response Team.

## CB 119981 Amendment 1 Summary:

Legislative Intent for <u>future</u> Salary Savings

- Provide flexibility to address emerging issues, mitigate recent officer separations and prioritize obligations under the Federal Consent Decree and the City Charter to provide adequate public safety services.
- Fund staffing for more quickly returning special events and the mass vaccination sites by ensuring a civilian /sworn staffing mix that allows SPD to prioritize sworn staff for patrol and 911 response needs.
