partnership, located in a portion of Lots 6, 7, and 8, together with a portion of the vacated alley abutting Lot 8, Block 17 of Town of Seattle, as laid out by D. S. Maynard, commonly known as D.S. Maynard's Plat of Seattle, for the purposes of constructing, repairing, replacing, and maintaining a Yesler Way abutment wall, sidewalk, and other transportation infrastructure; placing the real property rights and interests conveyed by such easement under the jurisdiction of the Seattle Department of

Transportation; and ratifying and confirming prior acts.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement project; authorizing the Director of the Seattle Department of Transportation to acquire, accept, and record, on behalf of The City of Seattle, a permanent easement from Neubert Family Limited Partnership, a Washington limited partnership, located in a portion of Lots 6, 7, and 8, together with a portion of the vacated alley abutting Lot 8, Block 17 of Town of Seattle, as laid out by D. - Seattle, for the purposes of constructing, repairing, replacing, and maintaining a Yesler Way abutment wall, sidewalk, and other transportation infrastructure; placing the real property rights and interests conveyed by such easement under the jurisdiction of the Seattle Department of Transportation; and ratifying and confirming prior acts.
- WHEREAS, the Yesler Bridge (Bridge) was built in 1910 and displays unique and historic design elements which include decorative pedestrian railings, ornamental capitals, casings, and corbels on the exterior fascia girders; and
- WHEREAS, the Bridge is located over 4th Avenue South at the intersection of Yesler Way, Terrace Street, and 4th Avenue South in the Pioneer Square Historic District, just a few blocks north of King Street Station; and
- WHEREAS, historic preservation is a key element of the Yesler Way Over 4th Avenue South Bridge Project, a project under the Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement project (Yesler Bridge Project), as the Bridge is one of the oldest steel bridges in Seattle; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation is working closely with the Pioneer Square Preservation Board and the International Special Review District Board to ensure that the Bridge and nearby neighborhoods maintain their key historic features and setting, while also addressing the Bridge's safety and maintenance risks; and
- WHEREAS, it is critical that the City accept the property rights necessary for construction of the Yesler Bridge

 Project to rehabilitate the Bridge to improve public safety in Pioneer Square and the International

 District as well as to enhance the service life and maintenance of the Bridge; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Easement granted by Neubert Family Limited Partnership, a Washington limited partnership, a copy of which is attached to this ordinance as Attachment A and recorded under Recording Number 20150821001203, dated August 3, 2015, for a portion of tax parcel number 524780-1045, is accepted. Section 2. The Easement referenced above shall be placed under the jurisdiction of the Seattle

Department of Transportation. Funding for the Yesler Bridge Project, including this property acquisition, comes

from bonds backed by the Commerci	al Parking Tax and	l a grant from the Federal	Highway Bridge Program.
Section 3. Any act consistent	with the authority	and prior to the effective	date of this ordinance is
ratified and confirmed.			
Section 4. This ordinance shall	ll take effect and b	e in force 30 days after its	s approval by the Mayor, but if
not approved and returned by the Ma	yor within ten day	s after presentation, it sha	ll take effect as provided by
Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.	020.
