BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Director of the Human Services Department, the Fire Chief, and the Chief of Police are

authorized to accept the following non-City funding from the grantors listed below, and to execute, deliver, and
