ORDINANCE _____

COUNCIL BILL

AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment; authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement between The City of Seattle and the Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

WHEREAS, the previous agreement between The City of Seattle and Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild that

established wages, hours, benefits, and other conditions of employment expired on December 31, 2014;

WHEREAS, employees represented by the Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild continued to work after the

agreement expired on condition that the subject of their wages, hours, benefits, and other conditions of employment continue to be negotiated; and

- WHEREAS, collective bargaining has led to an agreement between The City of Seattle and the Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild; and
- WHEREAS, separate, future legislation will be forwarded by the City Budget Office to provide department budget appropriation authority to cover compensation authorized in the collective bargaining agreement attached to this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of The City of Seattle (City) to execute a collective bargaining agreement between the City and the Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 1 and identified as "Agreement By and Between The City Of Seattle and the Seattle Police Dispatchers' Guild."

Section 2. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
