ORDINANCE	
COUNCIL BILL	

AN ORDINANCE conditioning the Seattle Department of Transportation's 2018 grant applications. WHEREAS, the Seattle Department of Transportation applies for a variety of state, federal, and other external

funding grants to construct the transportation projects identified in the City's Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to affirm support for large capital projects in advance of the Seattle

Department of Transportation applying for external grants; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance does not direct or require that the Seattle Department of Transportation apply for specific grants; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance may be amended during 2018 to reflect emerging funding opportunities or capital priorities; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In 2018, the Seattle Department of Transportation is prohibited from applying for project grants of \$5,000,000 or more of external funding, except for the projects authorized in Section 2 of this ordinance. This prohibition applies only to competitive grant programs.

Section 2. In 2018, the Seattle Department of Transportation is authorized to apply for grants for the following projects:
