A RESOLUTION modifying the Mayoral Civil Emergency Order of October 29, 2021, related to hiring incentives for public safety emergency response.

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, Mayor Durkan issued a Proclamation of Civil Emergency declaring a civil emergency within the City of Seattle based on the confirmed spread of COVID-19 in King County and resulting deaths; and

WHEREAS, since the murder of George Floyd in 2020, the Black Lives Matter movement has consistently advocated for moving resources away from repressive policing, and instead investing those resources into building community based public safety initiatives, including demanding that the City of Seattle reduce the size of the Seattle Police Department; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2021, a majority of the Seattle City Council voted against a proposed budget amendment that would have authorized the Seattle Police Department to offer hiring bonuses to
