CITY OF SEATTLE

ORDINANCE _____

COUNCIL BILL _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment; authorizing execution of a collective bargaining agreement between The City of Seattle and the Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898 to be effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2018; amending Ordinance 125207, which adopted the 2017 Budget, by increasing appropriations to the Seattle Fire Department for providing the 2015, 2016, and 2017 payments therefor; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement between The City of Seattle (City) and the Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898 expired on December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, employees represented by the Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898 continued to work after December 31, 2014, on condition that the subject of their wages continued to be negotiated during collective bargaining; and

WHEREAS, collective bargaining has led to a tentative agreement concerning wages, benefits, and other conditions of employment between the City and the Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of The City of Seattle to execute a collective bargaining agreement with the Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898, effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2018, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 1 and identified as “Agreement by and between the City of Seattle and Seattle Fire Chiefs Association, IAFF, Local 2898, AFL-CIO-CLC,” after union

membership has ratified the agreement.

Section 2. In order to pay for necessary costs and expenses incurred or to be incurred in 2017, but for which insufficient appropriations were made due to causes that could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the making of the 2017 Budget, appropriations for the following items in the 2017 Budget are increased from the funds shown, as follows:

Funding in future years will be appropriated through the annual budget process.

Section 3. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken prior to its effective date is ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
