RESOLUTION
A RESOLUTION modifying the Mayoral Civil Emergency Order of October 29, 2021, related to hiring incentives for public safety emergency response.  WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, Mayor Durkan issued a Proclamation of Civil Emergency declaring a civil
emergency within the city of Seattle based on the confirmed spread of COVID-19 in King County and
resulting deaths; and
WHEREAS, on October 29, 2021, pursuant to the civil emergency declaration, the Mayor issued a civil
emergency order authorizing immediate hiring incentives for public safety emergency response; and
WHEREAS, Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) subsection 10.02.020.B states, "[t]he Council may by
resolution, modify or reject the order. If the Council modifies or rejects the order, said modification or
rejection shall be prospective only, and shall not affect any actions taken prior to the modification or
rejection of the order"; NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT:
Section 1. The civil emergency order by Mayor Durkan related to hiring incentives for public safety
emergency response, dated October 29, 2021, and attached to this resolution as Exhibit A, is modified as shown
in Exhibit B.
