










Alaskan Way Viaduct REPLACEMENT



- Crews will use lane closures to install large foundations for four sign structures starting Saturday, March 7.
- Single-lane closures on SR 99 / Aurora Avenue
 North between Valley Street and the Aurora Bridge.
 - Phase 1: One southbound and one northbound lane closed.
 - Phase 2: One southbound lane closed.
- Southbound bus-only lane restriction will be lifted during work.
- Will complete work prior to busy summer event season.






- Ground settlement in the Pioneer Square area remains stable.


