Budget & Revenue

- HB 2044 (Duerr) Removes the restriction on levy lid lift funds supplanting existing funds.
- SB 5770 (Pedersen) Increases the property tax revenue limit for local property taxes

Climate & Environment

- HB 2049 (Berry)/SB 6005 (Lovelett) Holds producers of paper and packaging responsible for paying for curbside recycling for all Washington residents.
- HB 2232 (Doglio)/SB 6052 (Nguyen) Governor request legislation requiring petroleum industry to provide transparency for supply, pricing, transportation, etc. for petroleum products.
- HB 2201 (Doglio)/SB 6058 (Nguyen) WA carbon market linkage with California-Quebec market.
- HB 1185 (Hackney) Extends state's existing program to pay for the disposal of mercury-containing lightbulbs.

General Government

- HB 1932 (Gregerson) Permits cities, towns, and certain special purpose districts to choose to hold their elections in even-numbered years instead of odd-numbered years.
- SB 5838 (Nguyen) Creates an Artificial Intelligence Task Force to assess uses, develop guiding principles, and make recommendations for the regulation of generative artificial intelligence.
- HB 1951 (Shavers) Prohibits a deployer from using an automated decision tool that results in algorithmic discrimination, and permits the AGO to bring an action under the Consumer Protection Act.

Healthcare & Behavioral Health

- SB 5923 (Wellman) Requires education to prevent fentanyl and other opioid use to be provided once a year to all students in seventh and ninth grade. Directs OSPI to revise the health and physical education K-12 learning standards to include knowledge and understanding related to fentanyl, opioid, and other lifethreatening drug use.
- SB 5804 (Kuderer) Requires all school districts to obtain and maintain at least one set of opioid overdose reversal medication doses in each of the public schools.
- SB 5986 (Cleveland) Establishes balance billing protections for certain ground ambulance services.

Housing & Homelessness

- HB 2160 (Reed) Requires cities to allow the following amount of density around transit stops:
 - 3.5 FAR within 0.5 miles of a rail stop.
 - 2.5 FAR within 0.25 miles of a bus rapid transit stop
- SB 1998 (Gregerson) Requires local governments to allow co-living housing in any area that allows multifamily housing and prohibits local governments from imposing certain regulations on co-living housing.
- HB 2114 (Alvarado) Relating to housing stability for tenants
 - Limits rent and fee increases to 5 percent a year and prohibits increases within the first year.
 - Includes rent and fee increase notice requirements; tenant lease termination provisions; limits on move-in fees, security deposits, and late fees; and requirements for parity between month-to-month and longer-term rental agreements.

Labor & Commerce

- HB 1905 (Mena) Amends the Equal Pay and Opportunities Act to include all protected classes.
- SB 6040 (Valdez) Requires payment to subcontractors that are state certified small, women, and minority owned or disadvantaged business enterprises to be paid no later than 30 days after the work is accepted by the state or municipality, regardless of when the prime contractor receives payment.
- SB 5777 (Keiser) Extends unemployment benefits to employees on strike.

Public Safety & Criminal Justice

- HB 1062 (Peterson) Establishes a presumption of inadmissibility for statements made during a custodial interrogation where officer intentionally engages in deception.
- HB 2027 (Doglio) Requires sheriffs, marshals, police chiefs, and reserve officers to comply with background investigation to obtain certification.
- HB 2245 (Bronoske) Requires UW to establish a co-response training academy.
- Gun violence prevention
 - SB 5444 (Valdez) Restricting firearms in sensitive places
 - HB 1920 (Berry) Requiring permit to purchase or transfer firearm
 - HB 2021 (Senn) Authorizes local gov and law enforcement to dispose forfeited firearms.



Social Programs & Education

- HB 2058 (Riccelli)/SB 5964 (Nobles) Free school meals.
- SB 5870 (Wilson) Provides that ECEAP & WCC eligibility is met if household is receiving basic food benefits.
- HB 2101 (Rule) Eliminating child care licensing fees.
- SB 5774 (Billig) Increasing capacity for child care employees by improving fingerprint background system.
- HB 2007 (Peterson) Expands TANF time limit extension to include circumstances where termination of cash assistance would result in financial distress for recipient's family.

Transportation

- SB 5959 (Liias)/HB 2384 (Donaghy) Modifies local automated traffic safety camera authority, enforcement, requirements, and restrictions.
 - Allows cities to place traffic cameras on state routes within city limits
 - Makes permanent block the box and transit lane camera authority and expands the authority to cities with pop. of 90,000.
 - Allows any trained public employee to review violations and issue notices
 - All revenue generated by a traffic camera remains with the local government but must be used for traffic safety purposes.
 - Allows cities to grant requests for reduces fines/penalties
- HB 1963 (Ramos) Requires that license plates must be uncovered
