

Amendment 3 to CB 121052 Material Update to CCTV Policies

Non-disclosure Warrants

Effect: The Seattle Police Department (SPD) shall include in the annual report required by Ordinance 127110 whether a warrant, subpoena, or court order that includes a non-disclosure order, has been used to obtain Closed-Circuit Television Camera Systems (CCTV), Real Time Crime Center (RTCC), Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR), or other protected data from a contracted vendor.

The report shall indicate how SPD will remedy the situation, including steps that might be taken to discontinue collecting certain data or to end the CCTV pilot program. Upon receipt of this report, the Council might consider passing an ordinance to pause or eliminate the CCTV program to prevent third parties from accessing Seattle's protected surveillance data.

Add a new Section 2 as follows and renumber subsequent sections:

Section 2. The Seattle Police Department (SPD) shall include in the annual report required by Ordinance 127110 whether a warrant, subpoena, or court order that includes a non-disclosure order, has been used to obtain Closed-Circuit Television Camera Systems (CCTV), Real Time Crime Center (RTCC), Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR), or other protected data from a contracted vendor.
