- 7.6 million individuals face eviction each year, nearly 40% are children







- Unit matching by resident in easy to print and share lists
- Ability to search for units by rental barrier
- Easy to track financial request and support tickets
- Streamlined information sharing about potential residents





Solutions for Housing Stability

- Up to 3 months of emergency rental assistance
- Up to **\$5,000 damage mitigation**
- 1-month vacancy loss
- 2 years of housing-stability support (case management)
- Single **point of contact** for property support after move-in
- Eviction, mitigation and diversion support



Property Engagement

- Understand the business of housing providers and design solutions to solve their problems.
- The financial incentives will bring them in as partner, the stability solutions will keep them.
- Design solutions that operate at the speed of the housing market.
- Old data is bad data. Mechanism for managing unit availability is critical to compete for units and simplify the process for leasing agents.
- Single point of contact to address stability issues.



Technology and Housing Stability

- Technology is not the solution to homelessness...housing is.
 - But technology can bring efficiency to better serve people.
- Automated messaging and property connections gain us early indication of destabilizing events.
 - Upstream prevention reduces homelessness system inflow. Prevention is more cost effective than emergency response.
- Technology can make complicated problems simple for case managers and clients.
 - Don't ignore the skills and abilities of the people being served.
