The death toll has included Americans, and tens of 21 thousands more have been wounded; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the Associated Press has reported that more than 4,100 of those killed were children, including over 2,000 under the age of 12, and over 600 who were 3 and under; 24 25 and WHEREAS, as of November 1, the Israeli military admitted to having dropped 10,000 bombs on 26 27 Gaza, which averages 72 bombs for every square mile of Gaza, whose entire area is its

WHEREAS, while Israeli citizens have the right to defend themselves against all forms of
