Dear Ms. Rutzick,

This is an exciting time in Seattle's history. An influx of new residents, development capital, changes in neighborhood zoning, expanded transportation systems, and housing equality are just a few issues facing design projects in our city today. When things are moving so quickly, it's crucial to ensure Seattle's neighborhoods are designed in a manner which maintains their diversity, character, and values.

I understand the Seattle Department of Construction & Inspections is reviewing applications for Design Review Board members, and Jim Graham has recommended I apply. I would be very pleased to be considered for the Southwest Local Resident Representative position.

I spent a decade studying, traveling, learning, and working as a generalist architect before focusing on retail, restaurants, specialty collections and public spaces. It's been six years since I shifted focus, and in that time I've worked in numerous permitting jurisdictions all over the US and Canada, oversaw the design and construction of projects ranging from 500 square foot juice bars to 8,000 square feet retailers, and have helped plan & program street level uses for multi-block developments.

In my free time, I also work to give people the knowledge and vocabulary needed to advocate for better design in their city. I have extensive experience leading groups and speaking in public. A summary of my community engagement, leadership, and continuing education can be found on the following pages, but below are a few details I'd like to highlight.

In 2010, I won multiple design awards from the Socio Design Foundation, an independent group seeking to further the dialog of architecture's sociological impact.

I was a finalist for the AIA Seattle Emerging Professionals Traveling Scholarship in 2012 with my proposal to study urban agriculture and public markets in Northern Europe.

From 2011 – 2014, I served as co-chair of the public lecture committee at the Seattle Architecture Foundation, a not for profit which works to connect people to the influence of design, and inspires them to engage in shaping their city. Under my leadership, we began the (now) annual 6-part public lecture series which drew up to 200 people per event and created a toolkit to ensure the success of the program into the future.

In my new position on the SAF Board of Directors, I am currently helping to develop a new program for SAF in partnership with the department of neighborhoods. The spring 2017 series of events will highlight the impactful work of neighborhood coalitions that are shaping Seattle through grassroots design projects, and aims to share resources and best practices with other community leaders so they too can create positive change.

Outside the design community, I am involved in advocating for youth in King County's foster care system and raising awareness of Treehouse for Kids. In 2016, I chaired a committee of Young Professional Board volunteers in planning a 150-person philanthropic event which raised \$8,000 for the organization.

I look forward to discussing how I can be of service to the Southwest Neighborhood Design Review Board. Attached you can find my resume and application.
