

- Monitoring and analyzing legal and financial conditions related to the City's contractual relationships with public, non-profit and private partners including City-chartered Public Development Authorities (PDAs).
- Identifying and assessing legal and financial risks, and developing appropriate strategies for managing those risks.
- Preparing policy, legal and financial analyses to explain and/or support issues or positions; assessing implications of alternative decisions and actions; and preparing implementation and financing plans.

### *Finance Manager, 2013-2014*

Parks Division, Department of Natural Resources and Parks (DNRP), King County

- Provided oversight to the accounting, capital, operating, and payroll operations within the Division.
- Developed improved systems to more effectively monitor and respond to needs in the Parks capital development program under the expanded Parks Levy, approved by voters in August 2013.
- Provided financial oversight for the annual reporting of Parks capital and operating finances to the Parks Citizen Oversight Board (COB) appointed by the King County Council.

- Provided centralized oversight and support of budget and policy development across seven Executive departments representing over \$300 million in General Fund, levy, and grant resources.
- Convened and managed two inter-departmental teams identifying ongoing cost and operational efficiencies for the City's health care plans, and developing a common outcome framework across five City departments working in the area of early childhood literacy. Results recognized as part of the Mayor's budget presentations to the City Council in 2011 and 2012.
- Directly managed the centralized rate setting processes for employee benefits, including the Health Care Workers Compensation, and Unemployment Subfunds, totaling over \$185 million. Identified and implemented ongoing cost efficiencies in all three Subfunds during 2009-2012.
- Chosen by Mayor Nickels Administration to participate in City Leadership Institute (CLI) program (2009).

### *Budget Analyst, Strategic Advisor II, 2003-2006*

- Worked in collaboration with other City departments to evaluate and present budget proposals, track revenues and expenditures, and advised on fiscal and policy issues to the Department Director and Mayor as they arose.
- Analyzed and presented complex financial data for decision making, including development of a \$50 million loan fund for the Rainier Valley businesses during link light rail construction.
- Managed Citywide budget process providing organizational structure to the Department of Finance and other City departments in preparing and submitting budget proposals for consideration by the Mayor's Office. Recognized for implementing efficiencies to the Department's internal budget development process, with changes remaining in place today.
