Alicia Teel OED 2024 Commerce Grant ORD D1c 1 CITY OF SEATTLE ORDINANCE 127002 2 3 COUNCIL BILL 120747 4 5 AN ORDINANCE relating to grant funds from non-City sources; authorizing the Director of the 6 Office of Economic Development to accept specified grants and execute related 7 agreements for and on behalf of the City; amending Ordinance 126955, which adopted 8 the 2024 Budget; changing appropriations to various departments and budget control 9 levels, and from various funds in the Budget; and ratifying and confirming certain prior 10 acts. 11 WHEREAS, on September 14, 2023, the Wing Luke Museum sustained significant property 12 13 damage in an act of vandalism that was an apparent hate crime; and 14 WHEREAS, the Wing Luke Museum is a significant and unique cultural asset in Seattle as the 15 only pan-Asian Pacific American community-based museum in the United States, in 16 addition to being a National Park Service Affiliated Area and a Smithsonian affiliate; and 17 WHEREAS, the City and the Washington State Department of Commerce have jointly 18 committed \$100,000 to the Museum assist with repairs; and WHEREAS, the City, having an existing contractual relationship with the Museum, will serve as 19 20 the entity to reimburse the Museum for these repairs, up to \$100,000; and 21 WHEREAS, the share of funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce requires 22 execution of an interlocal agreement contingent on acceptance of this funding as a grant; 23 and 24 WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.22.570 and 35A.11.040, the City's legislative body has the 25 power to accept grants; NOW, THEREFORE, 26 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 27 Section 1. The Director of the Office of Economic Development is authorized to accept 28 the following non-City funding from the grantor listed below, and to execute, deliver, and

- 1 perform agreements for the purposes described below. The funds, when received, shall be
- 2 deposited in the receiving fund identified below to support, or as reimbursement for, the
- 3 corresponding appropriations set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance.
