1 **CITY OF SEATTLE** ORDINANCE_125744 2 COUNCIL BILL 119 422 3 4 5 AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation; imposing controls upon the Edris Nurses 6 Home, a landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal Code, and adding it to the Table of Historical Landmarks 7 8 contained in Chapter 25.32 of the Seattle Municipal Code. 9 10 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal 11 Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites, 12 improvements, and objects having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering, or 13 geographic significance; and 14 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board"), after a public meeting on April 4, 15 2018, voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 2120 1st Avenue 16 North and a portion of the site on which the improvement is located (which are 17 collectively referred to as the "Edris Nurses Home") for designation as a landmark under 18 SMC Chapter 25.12; and 19 WHEREAS, after a public meeting on May 16, 2018, the Board voted to approve the designation 20 of the Edris Nurses Home under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 21 WHEREAS, on August 1, 2018, the Board and the Edris Nurses Home's owner agreed to 22 controls and incentives to be applied to specific features or characteristics of the designated landmark; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance 25 approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designation. Under Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board") of the improvement located at 2120 1st Avenue North and a portion of the site on which the improvement is located (which are collectively referred to as the "Edris Nurses Home") is acknowledged.

A. Legal Description. The Edris Nurses Home is located on the property legally described as:

Parcel A of City of Seattle Short Subdivision 77-96, recorded December 13, 1977 under Recording Number 7712130694, as amended by document recorded January 31, 1978 under Recording Number 7801311074, in King County, Washington.

- B. Specific Features or Characteristics Designated. Under SMC 25.12.660.A.2, the Board designated the following specific features or characteristics of the Edris Nurses Home:
- 1. A portion of the site enclosed by the north, west, and east boundaries of the property, and the south edge of the easement recorded December 13, 1977 under Recording Number 7712130694, as amended by document recorded January 31, 1978 under Recording Number 7801311074, in King County Washington.
 - 2. The exterior of the building.
- C. Basis of Designation. The designation was made because the Edris Nurses Home is more than 25 years old; has significant character, interest, or value as a part of the development, heritage, or cultural characteristics of the City, state, or nation; has integrity or the ability to convey its significance; and satisfies the following SMC 25.12.350 provisions:
- 1. It is associated in a significant way with a significant aspect of the cultural, political, or economic heritage of the community, City, state, or nation (SMC 25.12.350.C).

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- B. City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) Approval Process.
- 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 of this ordinance according to the following procedure:
- a. The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
- b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.
- 2. If the CHPO does not approve the alterations or significant changes, the owner may submit revised materials to the CHPO, or apply to the Board for a Certificate of Approval under SMC Chapter 25.12. The CHPO shall transmit a written decision on the owner's request to the owner within 14 days of receipt of the request. Failure of the CHPO to timely transmit a written decision constitutes approval of the request.
- 3. CHPO approval of alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of the Edris Nurses Home that were designated by the Board for preservation is available for the following:
- a. The installation, alteration, or removal of ducts, conduits, HVAC vents, grills, pipes, panels, weatherheads, wiring, and other similar mechanical, electrical, and telecommunication elements necessary for the normal operation of the building or site.
- b. Installation, removal, or alterations of exterior light fixtures, exterior security lighting, and security system equipment.

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to provide a certified copy of this ordinance to the Edris Nurses Home's owner.

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1	Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
