BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To implement Ordinance 124490, the following salary rates are established as shown:



20 instead.


21 Section 6. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken after its passage
22 and prior to its effective date is ratified and confirmed.

1 Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
2 the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3 shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
