Final figures for 2017 are not available. However, in 2016 Career Quest provided 82 scholarships to employees from 24 City departments who had an average of 10 years of service with the City. Fifty-seven percent of the participants were female; and approximately 52 percent were people of color.

Career Quest's 2017 Adopted Budget of \$150,000 supported scholarships for the first three quarters of 2017. To fund all four quarters in 2018, the program identified a shortfall of \$50,000. This budget action fully funds this identified shortfall.
