4.2.11 Environmental Justice

This section presents information on the environmental justice (EJ), including race and ethnicity, income status, and English proficiency of people in the Project vicinity. The Project's three generating facilities are located in Whatcom County, and the primary transmission lines cross through Whatcom County, Skagit County, and Snohomish County. Given that relatively limited information exists on EJ in the Project vicinity, this section relies on available U.S. Census Bureau (USCB) data for the respective state, county, census tract, and block group.

The term *environmental justice* means “fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people, regardless of race, color, national origin, income, and education with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of protective environmental laws, regulations, and policies” (United States Environmental Protection Agency [EPA] 2023). *Fair treatment* means “no group of people, including a racial, ethnic or a socioeconomic group, should bear a disproportionate share of negative environmental consequences from industrial, municipal, and commercial operations or the execution of federal, state, local and Tribal programs and policies. The EPA has expanded the concept of fair treatment to include not only consideration of how burdens are distributed across all populations, but the distribution of benefits as well” (EPA 2023) *Disproportionate effects* describes “situations of concern where there exists significantly higher and more adverse health and environmental effects on minority populations, low-income populations, or indigenous peoples” (EPA 2023).

Meaningful involvement means “potentially affected community residents have an appropriate opportunity to participate in decisions about a proposed activity that will affect their environment and/or health; the public's contribution can influence the regulatory agency's decision; the concerns of all participants involved will be considered in the decision-making process; the decision makers seek out and facilitate the involvement of those potentially affected” (EPA 2023).

Pursuant to Executive Order 14008, *Tackling the Climate Crisis at Home and Abroad*, and Executive Order 12898, *Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice in Minority Populations and Low-Income Populations*, as amended, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) is required to complete an analysis of potential impacts from Project operations on the local community in the vicinity of the Project to understand the impacts to human health and the environment as they relate to EJ communities, or communities that stand to be disproportionately impacted by construction of a new facility or the continued operation of an existing facility, including socioeconomic and/or sociocultural impacts.

Additionally, FERC plays an integral role in regulating large parts of the United States energy industry, having far-reaching impacts to the nation, especially regarding the move toward cleaner energy (FERC 2022). Although FERC is not required to comply with Executive Order 13985, *Advancing Racial Equity and Support for Underserved Communities Through the Federal Government*, FERC has voluntarily elected to participate in the process, in an effort to ensure everyone can benefit from the clean energy transition (FERC 2022). Pursuant to Executive Order

13985, FERC has developed an Equity Action Plan and recognizes that many of the licensed hydropower projects were constructed prior to implementation of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), or the issuance of executive orders related to equity or EJ (FERC 2022). The information compiled in this section is meant to support FERC's consideration of EJ communities as they relate to the relicensing process.

4.2.11.1 Affected Environment

The Skagit River Project is in the upper Skagit River Watershed, within the North Cascades National Park Complex and portions of Whatcom County, Skagit County, and Snohomish County, Washington. Within a five-mile buffer of the Project Boundary each state, county, census tract, and block group were analyzed for racial and ethnic statistics (Table B03002; USCB 2021a), poverty statistics (Table B17017; USCB 2021b), and English proficiency (S1601; USCB 2021c) using the 2021 USCB, 2017-2021, American Community Survey 5-year Estimate (Table 4.2.11-1).

The presence of EJ communities within the geographic scope of the Project was evaluated through the methods included in the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Promising Practices for EJ Methodologies in NEPA Reviews (Federal Interagency Working Group on Environmental Justice & NEPA Committee 2016). The methods begin with a selection of the appropriate geographic unit of analysis within the affected environment (e.g., census block,¹⁷⁷ block group,¹⁷⁸ census tract¹⁷⁹). For example, within the five-mile buffer of the Project, there are 2,803 census blocks, 198 block groups, and 75 census tracts, either partially or fully within the Project's area of analysis, that could potentially be impacted by the relicensing and continued operation of the Project. Block groups were selected for minority and low-income analysis. Census tracts were selected for non-English speakers' analysis as the USCB does not provide this data at the block group level.

It is important to note, census data is self-reported and can only be disaggregated to certain prescribed levels (e.g., census blocks, census tracts). This suggests that pockets of minority or low-income communities, including those that may be experiencing disproportionately high and adverse effects, may be missed in a traditional census tract-based analysis. This is why Census data also has the possibility of distortion of population breakdowns. However, census data is the most comprehensive and standardized database of the population composition and its distribution, as well as the recommended statistical source of data for environmental justice (EJ) analysis (Federal Interagency Working Group on Environmental Justice & NEPA Committee 2016).

¹⁷⁷ Census Blocks are the smallest geographic areas that the Census Bureau uses to tabulate decennial data. Blocks are statistical areas bounded by visible features, such as streets, roads, streams, and railroad tracks, and by nonvisible boundaries, such as selected property lines and city, township, school district, and county limits.

¹⁷⁸ Block Groups are statistical divisions of census tracts, are generally defined to contain between 600 and 3,000 people and are used to present data and control block numbering. A block group consists of clusters of blocks within the same census tract that have the same first digit of their four-digit census block number, which follows the 11 character Census Tract.

¹⁷⁹ Census Tracts generally contain between 1,200 and 8,000 people with an optimum of 4,000 people. Census Tract boundaries are delineated with the intention of being stable over many decades, so they generally follow relatively permanent visible features. Uniquely numbered with a numeric code of 11 characters, which corresponds to the state (2), county (3), and census tract (6).

Each method of analysis is described below prior to the block groups identified as EJ communities using the respective method. The assessment identified 23 EJ communities as minority populations using the fifty percent analysis, 37 as minority populations using the meaningfully greater analysis, and 63 as low-income populations using the low-income threshold analysis. Seventeen block groups, included in the analysis results above, were identified as an EJ community based on the fifty percent or meaningfully greater analysis, as well as low-income threshold analysis. The 198 block groups are detailed in Table 4.2.11-1 with their EJ classification by analysis method. The block groups that were identified as EJ communities and their location in relation to the Project Boundary are shown on maps provided in Appendix I of this Exhibit E.

Sensitive receptor locations are areas where the occupants are more susceptible to the adverse effects of exposure to toxic chemicals, pesticides, and other pollutants. Sensitive receptor locations (e.g., daycare facilities, schools, elderly housing, hospitals) within the geographic scope of analysis are identified on maps provided in Appendix I of this Exhibit E. The distances of the sensitive receptor location from the Project's transmission line are provided in Table 4.2.11-2 (listed roughly geographical from Ross Lake to Bothell Substation). No sensitive receptor locations were identified in close proximity to Project facilities such as powerhouses, dams, substations, or reservoirs.

EJ Communities Classification

Fifty Percent Analysis

The term *minority* means “individual(s) who are members of the following population groups: American Indian or Alaskan Native; Asian or Pacific Islander; Black, not of Hispanic origin; or Hispanic” (Council on Environmental Quality [CEQ] 1997; EPA 2023). A population is identified as minority in a potentially affected area by either a fifty percent analysis or meaningfully greater analysis. The fifty percent analysis highlights populations with a cumulative minority population that exceeds fifty percent in the affected area (CEQ 1997). The following block groups were identified as EJ communities in the area of analysis using the fifty percent analysis method (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in dark blue). Communities denoted with an asterisk are also identified as an EJ community with the low-income threshold analysis method (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in pink). These communities and their location in relation to the Project are shown on the maps included in Appendix I of this Exhibit E.

Meaningfully Greater Analysis

The meaningfully greater analysis highlights populations with a cumulative minority population percentage that is meaningfully greater than the minority population percentage in the general population. (CEQ 1997). The following block groups were identified as EJ communities in the area of analysis using the meaningfully greater analysis method of ten percent higher minority population than their respective county (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in light blue). Communities denoted with an asterisk are also identified as an EJ community with the low-income threshold analysis method (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in pink). These communities and their location in relation to the Project are shown on the maps included in Appendix I of this Exhibit E.

Low-Income Threshold Analysis

Low-income references “populations characterized by limited economic resources. The United States Office of Management and Budget has designated the Census Bureau’s annual poverty measure as the official metric for program planning and analysis” (EPA 2023). The low-income threshold analysis highlights populations within the affected area with an income below poverty level percentage, which is equal or greater than the respective county. The following block groups were identified as EJ communities in the area of analysis area using the low-income threshold analysis method (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in green). Communities denoted with an asterisk are also identified as an EJ community with the fifty percent and/or meaningfully greater analysis method (Table 4.2.11-1, illuminated in pink). These communities and their location in relation to the Project are shown on the maps included in Appendix I of this Exhibit E.

4.2.11.2 Environmental Analysis

The EJ communities identified includes 198 block groups, either partially or fully within the Project's five-mile area of analysis. The assessment identified 53.5 percent (106 block groups) as potentially impacted by the relicensing and continued operation of the Project under one or more analysis method. EJ communities identified by minority populations includes 60 block groups and 63 by low-income, of which 17 block groups overlap as minority and low-income populations.

Throughout the relicensing process, City Light has conducted extensive outreach and collaboration with licensing participants (LPs). In developing its Proposed Action, and throughout the relicensing process, City Light engaged with numerous LPs who represent specific EJ communities. These representatives include entities summarized below.

Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations

The Project is located in the upper Skagit River watershed. The Skagit River is the traditional territory of several Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations. The watershed and surrounding ecosystem support vital runs of anadromous fish that are key to the cultural, spiritual, and economic health of Indian Tribes. These anadromous fish, especially Chinook Salmon, are also important to other area residents, endangered Southern Resident killer whales, and the entire Puget Sound ecosystem. Recognizing this, City Light has embraced an ecosystem approach to

relicensing looking beyond what is strictly required under the FERC study criteria and focusing its relicensing studies to inform decisions on operating the Project over the new license term.

Cities/Towns

City Light engaged in outreach with the surrounding and potentially affected communities. As previously mentioned, FERC waived City Light's responsibility to conduct a public scoping meeting or site visit to the Skagit River Project. Instead, FERC solicited written comments, recommendations, and information, on the Scoping Document 1 (SD1). It is City Light's understanding these cities, towns, and county commissioners informed and represented the public within their respective communities. The following are the communities that City Light has been in extensive outreach and collaboration with throughout this relicensing process. Cities and towns

City Light has also proactively engaged with local media publications of general circulation and organizations such as the Skagit Watershed Council and the Glacier Peak Institute to foster additional awareness and engagement in the Project throughout other local communities including: Arlington*, Darrington*, Rockport*, Hamilton*, Lyman*, and Marblemount*.

Relicensing Process

Throughout the relicensing process, City Light has conducted extensive outreach and collaboration with licensing participants (LPs). In January 2019, City Light began a voluntary Study Plan Development Process with Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations, among resource agencies, and other interested parties (collectively, LPs) in advance of the formal relicensing process to identify resource issues that warrant study during relicensing.

City Light created the Cultural Resources Work Group (CRWG) in 2019 to coordinate with participants engaging in the Project relicensing process. Initially, the 2019 CRWG included City Light, three federally recognized Indian Tribes (Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe, Swinomish Indian Tribal Community, Upper Skagit Indian Tribe), and the National Park Service (NPS). City Light expanded the CRWG in 2020 to invite additional potentially interested parties to the relicensing process. The CR-01 Cultural Resources Data Synthesis was subsequently planned and executed in 2020 and 2021 through coordination with the expanded CRWG.

City Light initiated the Project relicensing with the filing of the PAD and associated Notice of Intent on April 27, 2020. Following the filing of its PAD, City Light continued meeting with LPs to discuss studies necessary to inform the relicensing process. City Light offered Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations actively participating in the relicensing process financial grants to aid and promote their contribution of experiences and knowledge to this relicensing process. To date, six Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations have entered into grant agreements to receive funding from City Light to facilitate their participation. City Light is also coordinating with one additional Indian Tribe actively participating in the relicensing process regarding a participation grant. FERC issued SD1 on June 26, 2020. Due to COVID-19, FERC waived 18 CFR § 5.8(b)(viii) and notified the public that it does not intend to conduct a public scoping meeting or site visit to the Skagit

River Project. Instead, FERC solicited written comments, recommendations, and information, on the SD1. If needed, a site visit may be held later in the relicensing process. Of the 35 Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations informed, five responded (Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe, Swinomish Indian Tribal Community, Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, Stillaguamish Tribe of Indians, Nlaka’pamux Nation Tribal Council).

City Light filed the Proposed Study Plan (PSP) on December 8, 2020. The PSP included a suite of 28 relicensing studies and responded to study requests from LPs, including Indian Tribes and Canadian First Nations. After extensive and careful review of LP comments on the PSP, City Light significantly expanded and modified its PSP in the Revised Study Plan (RSP) filed on April 7, 2021. The RSP included a proposed suite of 33 relicensing studies.

Following the filing of the RSP, City Light continued to work with LPs to attempt to resolve outstanding areas of disagreement regarding the proposed studies. On June 9, 2021, City Light filed a “Notice of Certain Agreements on Study Plans for the Skagit Relicensing” detailing additional modifications to the RSP that were agreed to between City Light and supporting LPs (Swinomish Indian Tribal Community, Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, National Marine Fisheries Service, NPS, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington State Department of Ecology, Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife). FERC issued its Study Plan Determination on July 16, 2021, approving with modifications City Light’s RSP. Specifically, FERC recommended that City Light include the Nlaka’pamux Nation Bands Coalition as a Canadian First Nation that should be consulted during the Properties with Traditional Cultural Significance Study. No study disputes were filed with FERC.

City Light filed its ISR on March 8, 2022, held ISR meetings March 21-23, 2022, and filed an ISR meeting summary on April 7, 2022. A number of LPs filed comments on the ISR and meeting summary, including requests for study modifications and new studies.

On August 8, 2022, the Director of the Office of Energy Projects issued a Determination on Requests for Study Modifications adopting one requested study modification in full and one in part and declining to approve the remaining modifications and requests for new studies. City Light implemented these study modifications and filed an Updated Study Report in March 2023.

City Light’s Proposed Action has been informed by the relicensing studies and other available information, together with continued dialogue with several Indian Tribes, Canadian First Nations, federal and state agencies, and other LPs. City Light’s Proposed Action includes various resource management plans that are anticipated to have significant benefits to resources of interest to EJ communities.

4.2.11.3 Proposed Resource Measures

The Proposed Action includes PME and resource management plans that are anticipated to have significant benefits to resources of interest to EJ communities. The Proposed Action is anticipated to address impacts to EJ communities under the existing license through ongoing engagement and partnerships in implementation of the license with Indian Tribes, Canadian First Nations, and representatives from cities, towns, and counties on behalf of the public and EJ communities within their respective jurisdictions.

4.2.11.4 Unavoidable Adverse Impacts

The Proposed Action is not expected to result in unavoidable adverse impacts to EJ communities.
