Cal E. Shirley

Calvin "Cal" E. Shirley was the vice president for Energy Efficiency Services at Puget Sound Energy where he was responsible for all energy conservation, demand response and customer renewable projects.

Subsequently he was appointed as vice president of customer solutions, responsible for several facets of customer care including, the customer call center, customer billing and collections, low income assistance, major customer accounts and new construction projects requiring electric and natural gas service. Cal remained with the Washington-based Puget Sound Energy, utility subsidiary of Puget Energy until his retirement from the company in 2013.

Prior to joining PSE in 2002, Cal worked in the public utility sector for 14 years including serving as Senior Manager of Energy Services for Snohomish County Public Utility District. In this role, he was responsible for developing new products and services while also leading energy efficiency programs. He also worked at Seattle City light where he helped to develop what was then a new approach focused on customer incentives to promote energy efficiency through new and enlarged service connection policies.

Cal also served as Deputy Director of King County's Community and Human Services for seven years focusing on various programs and services related to housing, mental health, public defense, aging, youth, veterans, developmental disabilities, and domestic violence for vulnerable populations.

Cal is currently an advisory board member and workshop facilitator for Bellevue-based Executive Development Institute (EDI), which develops culturally diverse leaders in public and private institutions. He has also previously served on the Board of the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (NEEA), The Regional Technical Forum, and the Advisory Council of Business Leaders for Climate Solutions (BLCS).

Cal is a graduate of the University of Washington, where he studied society and justice, judicial administration and public affairs. He is a resident of Bellevue and enjoys music, photography, art, and travel.
