

Amendment 1 Version 1 to CB 121153 Seattle Social Housing Developer ILA ORD

Sponsor: Councilmember Strauss

Require City Council Approval to Amend Social Housing Interlocal Agreement

Effect: The proposed CB 21153 would allow the Social Housing Developer Interlocal Agreement (ILA) to be changed in the future without approval from City Council. This is not typical practice, as normally City Council approval is needed both to adopt an ILA and to make future changes. This amendment would require City Council approval for future changes to the ILA.

Amend Section 1 of CB 121153 as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor or designee is authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Seattle Social Housing Developer substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 1, with such changes as the Mayor deems appropriate and are consistent with this ordinance. ~~The Mayor or designee is further authorized to execute amendments from time to time during the term of the agreement as the Mayor deems appropriate and consistent with this ordinance. The interlocal agreement may not be modified or amended, except by a written agreement executed by the City and the Seattle Social Housing Developer, which is subject to approval by the City Council.~~
