

### Amendment 1 to RES 32170 – Digital Kiosk Term Permit

**Sponsor:** Councilmember Hollingsworth

Direct City spending from digital kiosks to public art and activation of public spaces.

**Effect:** This amendment would add language directing the anticipated revenue to the City governed by the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Seattle and the Downtown Seattle Association be spent on public art and activation of public spaces.

Add a new Section 3 (and renumber subsequent sections) as follows:

Section 3. The City Council anticipates that proposed appropriations for revenues to the City agreed upon under the anticipated Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the DSA will support public art and community activation of public spaces in neighborhoods citywide.
