## Robert D. Kaplan Biography

Robert D. Kaplan was raised in Seattle and received his B.A. (Political Science) and J.D. from the University of Washington. After graduation from law school he served in VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America) being sited in Chicago. While in VISTA he worked with various community organizations in Chicago.

He returned to Seattle after his service in VISTA and practiced law as a partner in various law firms and as a sole practitioner. His practice consisted primarily of working with small businesses, charitable organizations, and artists and authors. His community based practice lead him to work and volunteer with organizations and individuals in the fields of health care, community development, legal services and the arts. He retired in 2014.

In addition to serving on boards of many private non-profit organizations and community organizations he served on the Seattle Planning Commission and the council of the Pacific Hospital PDA. He is currently on the board of the Seattle Art Museum, the Museum Development Authority and the Cross Cultural Health Care Program.

Mr. Kaplan was recognized in 1996 with an award from the American Bar Association's Business Law Section for his pro-bono work. In 2004 he was named Distinguished Alumnus of the University Of Washington Department Of Political Science.
