Background: Jaron is a Masters student at the University of Washington Evans School of Public Affairs, and will also pursue a Masters in Public Health. Recently, she worked as a Program Assistant and contributed to several publications at Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center under Dr. Rachel Ceballos where she studied female-invasive and breast cancer health disparities among Latina and African American women in Washington State. Her proudest recent accomplishment was her successful acquisition of a grant from Google in support of a smartphone app that she developed jointly with the University of Washington and Stanford University. The app is a text-message monitoring and evaluation tool designed to improve the efficacy of Peace Corps projects. She will continue to play a role in the utilization of these devices and data collection from countries in Latin America, Africa, Eastern Europe and Asia. Additionally, Jaron also serves on the board of the Seattle-Area Peace Corps Volunteers Association. Before serving as a U.S. Peace Corps volunteer in Guatemala from 2010-2012 where she became fluent in Spanish, she attended The Barrett Honors College at Arizona State University, where she was a member of the Division I NCAA Women's Water Polo Team. She earned a bachelor's degree in Political Science, with emphasis on Geographical Information Systems and Public Health, and earned honorary distinction for her thesis, which used geo-spatial modeling to measure the impact of fast-food outlets in low-income neighborhoods in metropolitan Phoenix.
