Section 4(B) – Include a protected bike lane on Montlake from the light rail station to Roanoke as part

of the final design.

Section 4. The City expects that during final design of the project, the State will refine

and incorporate the following components:

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B. Maximization of safety, functionality and attractiveness of project intersections,

pedestrian crossings, undercrossings, and pathways to allow for users of all ages and abilities.

Examples of strategies may include, but are not limited to, pedestrian refuges and further

widening of the portal edge on the west side of Montlake Boulevard to enhance pedestrian

experience. Additional refinements to the current design should align with the City of Seattle

Complete Streets policy, and include a protected bike lane providing direct access from the

potential bicycle and pedestrian bridge across the Montlake Cut, identified in Section 2, to East

Roanoke Street.
