

PROPOSED AMENDMENT 1

Council Bill 119771: Adding Emergency Childcare Services as a Temporary FEPP Levy Program

Sponsor: Councilmember Herbold

Brief Description: This amendment would add a monthly reporting requirement regarding the City's efforts to contract for emergency childcare services.

Proposed Amendment:

1. Insert a new Section 4, as follows:

Section 4. The Council requests that the Department of Education and Early Learning submit a monthly report to the Council, with the first report submitted by April 30, 2020, on the efforts to contract for emergency childcare services. At a minimum, the report should include:

- A. The number of emergency childcare sites currently operating and their locations;
 - B. The number of staff at each site;
 - C. The number of students at each site, including a disaggregation by the type of essential work that the parents perform;
 - D. The amount of funds spent on emergency childcare services; and
 - E. The financial impacts to other Families, Education, Preschool, and Promise Levy investments from redirecting resources to emergency childcare services.
2. Renumber existing sections as appropriate.
